**Requirements & Additional Notes**

- 90 days notice for rental – if less than 90 given to DMMO a Technical Supervisor may not be available for the show. This show requires a motor rental from Creative Corners and can not be rented out without the rental. Rental is included in the rental price with shipping up to \$1250.00. The motor rental requires up to an additional 4 hours of load-in with the Set Technician and one extra person.
- 30 days notice to the trucking company and for all warehouse loading.
- Technical supervisor for load in, and load out; total working hours per day may not exceed 14 hours (including 2 one hour breaks); each additional hour or part thereof will be billed at a rate of Fifty (\$50.00) per hour
- Air ride trailers (as specified) with full logistics package: E- track or logistics posts; load bars (2), straps (10) and packing blankets (10) for each trailer required. Rail shipment not permitted.
