Summary:

Des Moines Metro Opera is a major summer opera festival located in Indianola, IA. The company produces 3-4 new productions each season in a summer repertory schedule, presented within the intimate 467-seat theatre at the Blank Performing Arts Center. Our 53rd season includes Wagner's The Flying Dutchman, Janáček's The Cunning Little Vixen, and Stravinsky's The Rake's Progress.

Principle Duties and Responsibilities:

- Work under the Scene Shop Supervisor to help prepare, build, and modify scenery for the festival season.
- Assist in the repair, modification, or building of any shop or theater improvements.
- Assist in scenic changeovers as needed.
- Assist in run crew if needed to cover a sickness or injury in the Show Operations Department.

Dates of Employment:

Sunday, May 11 - Friday, July 25, 2025.

Compensation:

\$700/week during the festival season, overtime after 50 hours paid at a rate of \$16.80/hour \$300 travel stipend to be paid upon arrival.

DMMO will provide single occupancy air-conditioned dorm housing during the festival season.

- 3+ years of experience working in a scene shop
- Minimum BA/BFA in Theatre or equivalent professional experience
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills

- Ability to lift 50 pounds unassisted or with the help of a team
- Ability to work at heights
- Ability to wear and safely use a fall arrest harness
- Ability to hold and operate hand, air, and power tools.
- Work includes periods of standing, working in low light, climbing stairs/ladders, and working in a personnel lift
