Our 54th season consists of 3 mainstage productions with 2 new productions being built specific for DMMO's stage and the third built as a major co-production. DMMO is one of America's boldest Opera Companies (as reported by the New York Times) and was nominated for its 2024 season for an International Opera Award. Join our team in this a critical role to work on some of the most challenging, bold, intense, visually stunning, complex and rewarding productions of your career!

Principle Duties and Responsibilities:

The below responsibilities are in no means a complete list of tasks/responsibilities.

- Assist as part of the Hair & Makeup team with styling, maintenance, and upkeep of wigs during the run of shows.
- Help to maintain Des Moines Metro Opera's inventory of wig and make up stock.
- Assist the Wig and Makeup Shop Supervisor in building, ventilating, and styling wigs.
- Assist and manage performer hair prep and wig and makeup applications.
- Run backstage wig and makeup quick changes during the run of shows.
- Assist in returning all Wig and Makeup stock to storage at the end of the festival season.

Extra opportunities:

- To participate in workshops and talkbacks.
- Ability to work with other stage crews (such as stage carpentry, lighting, sound, props) as available.

Skills and Knowledge:

Any combination of education and experience providing the required skill and knowledge for successful performance would be qualifying. Typical qualifications would be equivalent to:

- Currently enrolled in or graduated from a technical theatre training program and/or more specific education and training working with hair, wigs and make-up.
- Some experience working as wig & makeup crew
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills
- Must be at least 18 years of age to apply.
- Willingness to try new things and learn.
- Ideally, OSHA 10 or greater qualifications.

Physical Requirements and Working Conditions:

- Ability to sit, stand, traverse a working stage/shop environment which includes ladders, uneven floors and workspaces typically in use backstage.
- Work includes extended periods of standing, working in low light, climbing stairs/ladders.
- Ability to lift heavy objects properly/safely
- Ability to wear eye protection, hearing protection, respirator and any other safety equipment that may be needed.
