### **Requirements & Additional Notes**

- 90 days' notice for rental – if less than 90 days given to DMMO, a Technical Supervisor may not be available for the show.
- 30 days' notice to the trucking company and for all warehouse loading.
- Technical supervisor for load in/load out; total working hours per day may not exceed 14 hours (including 2 one-hour breaks); each additional hour or part thereof will be billed at a rate of Fifty (\$50.00) per hour.
- Please note scenic floors are designed for DMMO's thrust stage containing a lift and an orchestra pit
- Air ride trailers (as specified) with full logistics package: E-track or logistics posts; load bars (2), straps (10), and packing blankets (10) required for each trailer. Rail shipment not permitted.
